It is my responsibility to track my reading experiences.

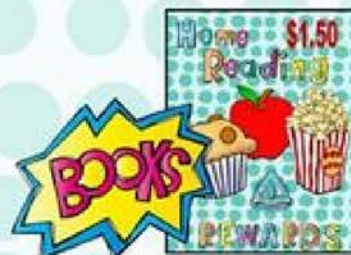
