Spotlight on Bribie – Important Information for Families

Dear Parents and Carers,

The countdown is on for our **Spotlight on Bribie Whole School Arts Showcase!** We are very excited to welcome our families for a wonderful evening celebrating the creativity, talent and hard work of our students.

To help the evening run smoothly and, most importantly, to ensure that all students are safely supervised throughout the event, please read the following important information regarding **arrival, drop-off and student care arrangements**.

🌟 Showcase Details

Date: Thursday, 10 September 2026
Student Arrival: Between 4:30 pm and 5:00 pm
Student Drop-Off: Undercover area in front of the Tuckshop
Show Begins: 5:30 pm
Approximate Finish: 8:00 pm

🚶 Student Arrival & Drop-Off

When you arrive, please bring your child to the **undercover area in front of the Tuckshop between 4:30 pm and 5:00 pm**.

Staff will be waiting to greet students and organise them into their performance groups. Students will then be lined up in **performance order** and taken to their assigned **holding room**.

Once your child has been signed into the care of staff, it will be a **"kiss and drop"** arrangement. Families can then make their way to the Showcase area to:

- purchase or present tickets;
- purchase food and refreshments;
- enjoy the wonderful student artwork on display; and
- find a seat in the hall ready for the 5:30 pm start.

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Student Supervision During the Evening

Each performance group will be assigned a **designated holding room**, where students will remain under staff supervision when they are not performing.

This arrangement is important as we have many students moving between different performances throughout the evening. Keeping students with their groups will allow us to safely manage **supervision, backstage movement and transitions between performances**, while also keeping the main auditorium settled for our performers and audience.

For this reason, we ask that families **do not collect students between individual performances**.

All Students Stay for the Finale

All students participating in the Showcase are required to remain with their group until the end of the evening.

Our Showcase concludes with our special **finale involving all participating students**, so even if your child performs earlier in the program, they will still be needed for the final performance.

The program is expected to finish at approximately **8:00 pm**. Further instructions regarding student collection at the conclusion of the Showcase will be provided on the evening.

Thank you for your support and cooperation with these arrangements. They will help us keep our students safe, organised and ready to perform while allowing the evening to run as smoothly as possible.

We cannot wait to share **Spotlight on Bribie** with you and celebrate everything our students have achieved!
