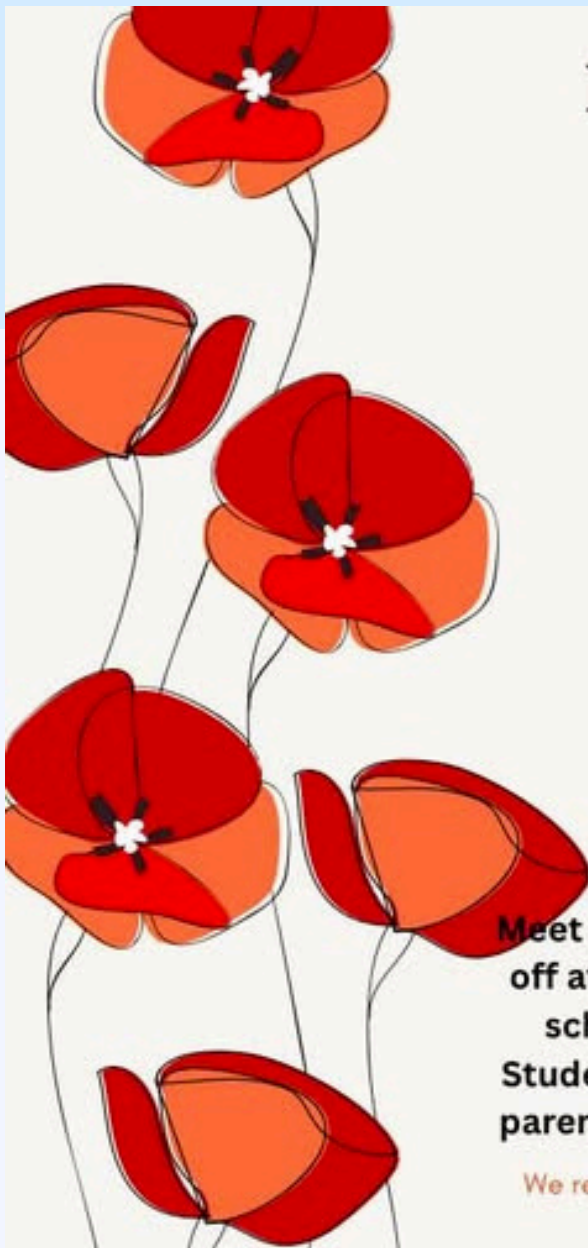

PROJECT NOTICE

Shared Path Upgrade - First Avenue, Bongaree

April 2026

I am pleased this work is about to commence as part of Council's Pathway Construction Program.

This project will provide improved pedestrian access and safety whilst ensuring a desirable level of service is achieved and ongoing maintenance costs are reduced.

As your divisional councillor, I thank you for your patience while we work to make City of Moreton Bay an even better place to live, work and play.

When will the work be done?

City of Moreton Bay Council is upgrading the shared pathway along First Avenue, Bribie Island at thirteen individual sites from Bongaree through to Woorim. The works are expected to commence mid April and take twelve weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Scope of works

The project scope includes upgrading sections of the existing bicycle and pedestrian path, along with installing new shared path line marking and wayfinding signage. In addition, safe-crossing treatments will be delivered at the following locations:

- Hunter Street / First Avenue intersection
- Goodwin Drive / First Avenue roundabout
- Boyd Street / First Avenue intersection

How will you be affected?

Please be assured that every effort will be made to minimise noise and any other impacts on surrounding properties, with works generally being undertaken during daytime hours between 7am and 6pm. Please observe the instructions of work crews and road signage, and plan your travel accordingly.

Due to the nature of works, residents' access and traffic flow may be affected. City of Moreton Bay construction team will liaise directly with local residents to help facilitate access during construction.

Important Information



The City of Moreton Bay regulates parking or stopping of vehicles on footpaths, bicycle paths, shared paths, dividing strips or nature strips.

Please note that vehicles that are parked with two wheels on the footpath/nature strip and two wheels on the road is not considered as a lawful parking practice.

Council is legally obliged to enforce these regulations, and our Proactive School Safety Patrol Program contributes to this enforcement. During Proactive School Safety Patrols, enforcement of unlawful parking is applied by obtaining photographic evidence and issuing a penalty infringement notice.

Council prefers that vehicle drivers are educated.
